

## CHARGERS VOLLEYBALL

The Chargers men's and women's volleyball teams collected three wins on the weekend against the visiting CBC Bearcats (Abbotsford). The women fell in four on Friday (CBC: 25-21, 20-25, 25-19, 25-16) but regrouped the following day to collect their third "w" of the season in straight sets (CAM: 25-22, 25-15, 25-20). Hilary Graham and Morgan Marshall were the top point makers for Camosun on Friday night, contributing 11 offensive points each. Graham scored 7 kills, 3 aces and 1 stuff block while Marshall, who leads the league in blocks (0.92 avg), had 7 kills, 1 ace and 1 block. Second-year leftside Carly Hilliard came in to lead the charge in Saturday's match with 13 kills, 2 blocks and 1 ace. The Chargers women are 3-7 and advance to fifth spot in the PACWEST standings.

The Chargers men swept past the Bearcats this weekend with two solid straight set victories (Fri: 25-16, 25-23, 25-16; Sat: 25-15, 26-24, 25-23). Third-year leftside Jeremy Finn (Westbank) led Camosun on Friday night with 13 kills, 1 ace and 5 digs. Second-year middle Alex Sadowski made 6 kills, 1 ace, 2 blocks and 3 digs. On Saturday, Alex Sadowski took the lead with 12 kills and 2 blocks. Fifth-year leftside Garrett Marcellus had 13 kills and 9 digs.
