CHARGERS BASKETBALL HOME GAME RESULTS

It was a battle on the boards this weekend at the Pacific Institute for Sport Excellence as the Camosun Chargers men's and women's basketball teams made their final effort to earn a berth to the PACWEST playoffs.

Entering the final weekend of regular season competition tied for the last qualifying spot, the pressure was on both Chargers teams to win. On Friday, both teams suffered disappointing losses to the visiting Kwantlen Eagles (W 61-47; M 83-76 OT). The losses, combined with an upset in the women's standings and anticipated jockeying on the men's side, forced the Chargers into a do-or-die situation. While it was simply a matter of winning Saturday's game for the Chargers men, the women had the added pressure of relying on PACWEST adversary, the Quest University Kermodes, to defeat the Langara College Falcons to secure a playoff spot. It all ended well following Saturday's results, with Camosun producing two solid wins against the CBC Bearcats (W 99-47; M 92-65) and the Langara women falling to Quest 66-56.

Third-year wing Elyse Matthews (Stelly's) led the Camosun women in both games with 16 points and 15 rebounds on Friday and 20 points and 7 rebounds on Saturday. First-year guard Evan Woodson (Oak Bay) led the Chargers men with 19 points Friday. The following day, second-year wing Drake Downer (Oak Bay) took the lead position with 19 points, 8 rebounds and 4 assists.

Seeded sixth, both Chargers teams enter this year's PACWEST Provincial Basketball Championships as the underdogs of the tournament which will be hosted by Camosun College at the Pacific Institute for Sport Excellence, February 28 – March 2.

CHARGERS VOLLEYBALL ROAD RESULTS

The Chargers volleyball teams scored one win out of four this past week as they battled through their final matches of the season against Island rivals, the VIU Mariners. On the women's side, Camosun went down in straight sets on Thursday and Saturday (25-18, 25-21, 25-16 and 25-17, 25-19, 25-19), to end the regular season 9-15. The Chargers men took the Mariners all the way to five on Thursday, defeating their opponents 15-25, 25-23, 25-19, 24-26, 15-13. In Saturday's contest, Camosun fell 3-0 (25-21, 25-22, 25-21), finishing the season with a record of 15-9.
