Weekend Re-Cap – November 9-10, 2012

CHARGERS VOLLEYBALL

The Chargers volleyball teams split their weekend matches with the visiting Douglas College Royals as Camosun went on to collect two big wins on Friday before falling in both their matches the following day.

The Chargers women collected their second win of the season on Friday, taking their opponents to an exciting 3-1 win (25-16, 25-17, 19-25, 25-23). Second-year leftside Carly Hilliard (Seaquam, Delta) led the Chargers with 17 kills, 4 stuff blocks and 2 aces. Third-year leftside Hilary Graham had 12 kills and 1 block. Saturday's five-set match was a test for both teams, but it was the visiting Royals who picked up the victory (25-20, 13-25, 17-25, 26-24, 15-11). Camosun's Hilary Graham had another big game contributing 20 kills, 1 ace and 11 digs. Second-year middle Morgan Marshall (Smithers) added 13 kills, 2 aces 1 block and 2 digs. Heading into Week 6 of PACWEST volleyball competition, the Chargers maintain seventh spot with a record of 2-6.

The Chargers men provided the undefeated Douglas College Royals with their first loss of the season on Friday night, claiming a thrilling four set victory over the defending PACWEST champions (21-25, 25-22, 25-17, 25-19). Fifth-year leftside Garrett Marcellus led the Chargers men with 15 kills, 3 aces and 1 block. Returnee and 2011-12 PACWEST Rookie of the Year Alex Sadowski made 8 kills, 2 aces and 5 blocks. The Royals came back swinging on Saturday and claimed the match 3-1 (25-19, 17-25, 25-13, 25-16). Fifth-year rightside Andrew Inglis (Red Deer) led the Chargers with 18 kills, 1 ace and 15 digs. With Friday's significant win over Douglas, the Chargers are 4-4 and advance in the CCAA National Rankings to No. 7 (#4 in PACWEST).

CHARGERS BASKETBALL

The Chargers basketball teams produced one win on the road this weekend as they made the trip over to the Mainland to take on the Langara College Falcons and the Douglas College Royals. The women's one-point win over Langara on Friday puts the squad at 1-2 and tied for fifth at the end of Week 2, while the men are 8th at 0-3.
