Camosun College values teaching excellence in its faculty and is committed to successful learning for its students. The School of Health and Human Services seeks to hire qualified term (sessional) instructors to teach in the Nursing Department where the vision is to educate nursing students through the following priorities:

- Learner-centred education that is accessible, flexible, and relevant.
- Teaching and nursing practice that honours each person's history, stories, and culture.
- Collaborative, respectful, and open environments that promote caring relationships.

As a term (sessional) faculty member you will be joining a dynamic team of nurse educators who are committed to excellence, collaboration, diversity, and learner-centered nursing education. We provide the first five semesters of the Baccalaureate of Science in Nursing, in collaboration with the University of Victoria. We inspire, educate, and transform nursing students for service to humanity through curiosity, innovation, and excellence.

Our faculty seek to balance clinical expertise and academic proficiency: Term (sessional) faculty may be required to teach theory, lab, and clinical practice courses. Qualifications of applicants and responsibilities reflect the need for, and development of, this balance, individually and collectively.

Successful candidates will be placed on an eligibility list for sessional opportunities in May and June (nursing practice), Fall 2018, and Winter 2019 terms. In May and June opportunities exist in the Consolidated Practice Experience (CPE) course for first or second year, in a full-time assignment. Other opportunities may exist in Fall and/or Winter semester and can involve theory, lab, or clinical course assignments.

Expectations of successful candidates include:

- Commitment to the scholarship of teaching; and willingness to actively participate in a learning centered college environment while promoting excellence in the discipline of nursing
- Excellence in nursing practice which is evidence- informed and inquiry-based
- Skill in planning, organizing and evaluating teaching approaches and outcomes to maximize student learning
- Engagement with current and trending philosophies and practices
- Participation in professional activities that contribute to the educational goals of the department, school and the College
- Participation in program curriculum development processes
- Adherence to and demonstrate compliance with teaching related policies, procedures and protocols
- Clarity and respect in verbal and written communications
- Collegial and collaborative work relationships

- Master's level education, in nursing or a related discipline, with a focus on nursing education or nursing scholarship (or enrolled in a Master's program) preferred
- Minimum of three years clinical experience
